Dear Participant

We are delighted to have you participate in the upcoming demo derby event organized by NS Provincial Exhibition. (Hereinafter referred to as "the Event") scheduled to take place on Wednesday August 6, 2025. Before your participation, it is important for you to understand the risks involved and to acknowledge and accept the responsibilities and liabilities associated with your involvement in the Event.

In consideration of being allowed to participate in the Event, I, the undersigned, hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

Assumption of Risks:

I am fully aware and understand that participating in a demo derby involves inherent risks, including but not limited to, collisions, vehicle damage, bodily injury, and other potential hazards. I acknowledge that I have been informed of these risks and voluntarily choose to participate in the Event, assuming all such risks willingly and at my own responsibility.

Release and Waiver:

I hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue All staff, volunteers, Organizers, sponsors affiliates, its officers, directors, employees, agents, and any other persons or entities involved in the organization or administration of the Event (collectively referred to as "the Released Parties"), from any and all liability, claims, demands, actions, or causes of action arising out of or relating to my participation in the Event, including but not limited to personal injury, property damage, or any other harm, whether caused by the negligence of the Released Parties or otherwise.

Indemnification:

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against all claims, demands, actions, liabilities, losses, damages, costs, or expenses (including attorney's fees) arising out of or relating to my participation in the Event, including but not limited to any claims brought by third parties arising out of my actions or omissions during the Event.

Medical Treatment:

In the event of any injury or illness that may occur during my participation in the Event, I authorize the Event organizers and their representatives to secure medical treatment, including emergency medical care, if deemed necessary. I understand that any medical expenses incurred will be my responsibility.

Insurance:

I acknowledge that I am responsible for obtaining and maintaining appropriate insurance coverage for myself and my vehicle(s) participating in the Event, including but not limited to liability insurance.

Governing Law and Severability:

This Waiver and Release of Liability shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province of Nova Scotia.

I have carefully read and understand this waiver and release of liability and voluntarily sign it as my own free act and deed, intending to be legally bound.

NSPE 2025 DEMOLITION DERBY CAR SETUP RULES

WEDNESDAY AUGUST 6, 2025

- 1. If the SUV is AWD the drive shaft must be removed to make it a front wheel drive vehicle.**
2. Stock gas tank behind the rear axle must be removed. Gas tanks in front of the rear seat are ok as is. An auxiliary gas tank MUST be no further than the rear of the front seat.
3. Auxiliary gas tanks MUST be securely fastened. NO bungee cords, wood or rope can be used.
4. Fire Shield MUST be placed between the driver and the tank. Fire shield is a non-flammable material securely fastened around the tank, completely covering the tank, to keep gas from splashing on the driver if it should rupture. Using the back seat as a shield is NOT good enough!
5. ABSOLUTELY NO one gallon or five gallon carrying cans (gas cans) are allowed to be used for auxiliary tanks. The auxiliary tank MUST have gas line fittings in place. NO lines can be jammed through a hole and sealed. A securely installed fitting will be acceptable.
6. Any fuel leakage will lead to immediate disqualification. Electrical fuel pumps are permitted, but must have a fuel shut off switch within the drivers reach. Fuel pump cut off switch is not needed if stock setup is being used.
7. Windshield is optional. All other glass must be removed (not smashed out) this includes all outside mirrors, taillights, headlights, and windshields. Any broken glass must be removed from the car. Rolling down the window is NOT acceptable.
8. Chrome mouldings, antenna, sun-visors, and dangerous objects MUST be removed.
9. Approved seat belts are required (original manufacturers equipment) and/or harness or extra seat belt.
10. A single post to post bar or pipe (max 4") may be welded or bolted from the driver's side "B" post to the passenger side "B" post. Drivers may also run a post or pipe (max 4") from the floor to the roof (rollover bar) to provide strength in the event of a rollover.
11. Only one automotive type battery is permitted and it may be located in any position in the car. Battery MUST be securely fastened and covered.
12. Radiator and transmission cooler MUST remain in the original position OR be removed.
13. NO CUTTING front bumper ends. Fenders may be cut for wheel clearance only.
14. Cars MUST be CLEANED OF ALL DEBRIS prior to coming to the track.
15. All cars must have brakes.
16. All entries must have a 24" diameter hole in the hood around the carburetor.
17. All doors must be securely fastened by chain, wire or welded.
18. The driver's door may be reinforced on the outside using plate steel, or grader blades. Reinforcing MUST NOT extend more than one foot behind or ahead of the driver's door.
19. The hood and trunk or tailgate may be fastened in four places. Wire or chain (no bigger than ¼") may be through each hole. NO BOLTS, PINS or WASHERS can be used. NO welds on hood, trunk or tailgate.

20. All fastened trunk lids MUST have a 12" diameter inspection hole cut in the trunk lid.
21. All flammable material except the dashboard and front seats MUST be removed. All airbag sensors must be disabled.
22. Only stock type bumpers are allowed. Any trailer hitches MUST be completely removed. NO REINFORCING.
23. No welding of seams or adding any metal to frame. Must be stock frame for that make and model. If the frame is broken, you may use 4"x4"x 3/8" thick patch on side of break only. NO other patch accepted. Over repaired frames will be considered reinforced and will result in disqualification.
24. ABSOLUTELY NO REINFORCING, ALTERING or WELDING rear leaf springs. Leaf springs MUST conform to stock equipment.
25. NO blocked shocks, spring jacks or shackles. Cars MUST have a free suspension. Air shock lines MUST be cut.
26. Both front doors should be painted white and left blank for your number until it is approved. Special numbers can be requested on the entry form, BUT they will be assigned on a FIRST DEPOSIT PAID basis.
27. Cars may only be decorated in good taste. NO nudity, profanity or hate graphics.
28. All work on cars must be completed before entering the track area.
29. Rims must be stock type and size, NO split rims. NO double or liquid filled tires. Passenger or light truck tires only. No studded tires, no tractor, skid steer, or off-road type tires.
30. A driver \$100 protest fee is required to contest another car. Fee will be refunded if car is found ineligible.



NSPE 2025 DEMOLITION DERBY GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. (One) entry per person. Officials reserve the right to accept or reject any application.
2. Each car entry of \$40 includes admission for the DRIVER and ONE (1) Pit Crew member. All other friends or family will be subject to the \$5.00 admission fee.
3. Only Full-bodied passenger hardtop automobiles or station wagons are allowed. NO Trucks or Jeeps, convertibles, Hearses, or limousines.
4. No derby cars are permitted in the competition area (Track Field) prior to the actual competition. All cars will go through a technical inspection for approval before entering.
5. ANYONE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS OR ALCOHOL WILL BE DISQUALIFIED, NO EXCEPTIONS
6. A car will be disqualified if the driver's door comes open during the event.
7. There will be no "Buddy System" or "Sandbagging". This may result in disqualification. HITS MUST BE AGGRESSIVE. Simple contact within the time limit DOES NOT constitute combat and MAY LEAD TO BEING DISQUALIFIED.
8. There will be NO hitting on the driver's side door.
9. When your vehicle is out of commission, the white flag attached to the vehicle by the derby committee personnel is to be broken off. Any competitors hitting a vehicle with a broken flag on purpose, will be disqualified at the judge's discretion.
10. There will be a horn used for starting and stopping, and caution stops as needed for the competition. This MUST be always followed.
11. A Drivers meeting will be held at 6:30pm SHARP prior to the start of the race time of 7:00pm. ALL cars must be through their technical inspection by this time. We recommend all drivers be onsite no later than 6:00pm
12. The Nova Scotia Provincial Exhibition, Rath Eastlink Community Centre, Derby committee, or any of its sponsors are not responsible for any cars, parts, or personal property, before, after or during the event.
13. ALL CARS must be removed from the track and pit area IMMEDIATELY following the competition. NO EXCEPTIONS
14. These rules supersede all rules previously in effect.
15. Safety glasses, goggles or face shield must be worn by all drivers. Department of Transportation approved helmets must also be worn. Its highly recommended all drivers wear a neck brace.
16. The decision of the Event Official will be Final.
